Hi Impact worked in Year 4 and 5 yesterday encouraging the children to work in teams on a breakout challenge. It was great fun!

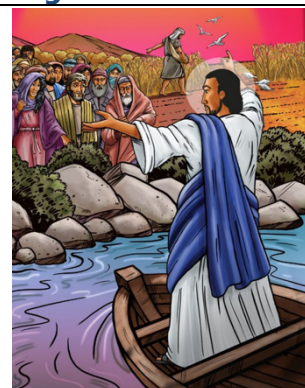
There was a 'Commotion in the Ocean' in F2 this week! After sharing the book, the children used chalk to create these fantastic drawings.
