<b>EYFS</b>	<p>The topics chosen are in line with the statutory requirement of the EYFS curriculum.</p> <p>Within EYFS the foundations are set for key Art and Design skills to develop, such as, developing motor skills, mark making, making choices about colours, textures and shapes, selecting materials, manipulating materials and giving opinions. Pupils develop knowledge of materials through sensory experiences. Children develop their own ideas through selecting and using materials and working on processes that interest them. Through their explorations, they find out and make decisions about how media and materials can be combined and changed.</p> <p>Being imaginative – children talk about the ideas and processes, which have led them to made designs, images or products. They can talk about features of their own and others' work, recognising the differences between them and the strengths of others.</p>
