BEING DIFFERENT



<u>Vocabulary</u>	
Bullying	When a person/ group of people are repeatedly hurting you; physically or emotionally
Disability	A physical or mental condition that limits a person's movements, senses or activities
Differences	A point or way in which people or things are dissimilar
Equality	The state of being equal
Inspire	Fill (someone) with the urge or ability to do or feel something, especially to do something creative
Paralympics	Olympic style games for people with impairments
Permanent	Lasting or intended to last or remain unchanged indefinitely
Temporary	Lasts for only a limited period of time—not permanent
Unique	Being the only existing one of its type e.g. we are all unique there are no two people who are the same.
Visually Impaired	Partially or completely blind
