**BEING DIFFERENT**



<b><u>Vocabulary</u></b>	
<b>Ageism</b>	When a person is treated unfairly due to their age
<b>Bullying</b>	When a person/ group of people are repeatedly hurting you; physically or emotionally.
<b>Disability</b>	A physical , mental or cognitive impairment that can be permanent
<b>Discrimination</b>	Unfair treatment of a person's personal characteristics e.g. race, disability, age, gender etc.
<b>Equality</b>	Treating everybody equally
<b>Equality Act</b>	A legal act from Parliament which protects people from Discrimination
<b>Racism</b>	A form of discrimination against a person with a different race to yourself
<b>Stereotypes</b>	An idea or belief many people have about a thing or group that is based on how they look on the outside , which may be true or only partly true
<b>Quote</b>	Words from a text or speech spoken by another person
