

Maths

This term we will continue to develop our understanding of ...

- number and place value; saying the number 1 more/ less than any number to 100
- read, write and say 2-digit numbers and understand them as tens and ones
- Revise number facts; pairs to 5, 6, 7, 10, doubles to double 10 and counting in 2s, 5s & 10s
- Name, recognise and know the properties of 3D shapes
- Recognise odd and even numbers
- Compare weights, lengths, time and capacities



Science

Materials

We will be finding out about different materials and their uses. Exploring how some materials in our world are natural and some are man made. We will investigate materials discovering whether a material is waterproof or not, developing our understanding of scientific vocabulary and thinking.

Forces

We will be finding out how we can move things like our scooters and bicycles by the force that we use and will link this to our topic on wheels and wings.

Main Topic

Our Wonderful World

We will take a whistle stop tour of the seven continents of the world visiting a country on each continent. On our journey we will explore each country and explore their features, people and landmarks.

Wheels Wings and other things

Hop on board and prepare to blast off on an exciting adventure finding out about travel and transport. We will explore journeys of all kinds, from a walk to school to a trip to the moon. We will be exploring how people travelled in the past to how people get around today.

English

We are going to...

- read lots of traditional stories and fairy tales including tales from other Cultures
- retell stories, develop and adapt familiar themes, for example changing the ending of 'The Three Little Pigs', writing about Goldilocks and the 3 wolves, etc.
- We will continue to make our sentences more interesting by using exciting vocabulary and linking our ideas with a range of connectives.
- We will learn how to write a non-chronological report, based on our topic our wonderful world.
- Poetry– learning how to write poems with rhyming couplets.



Geography

We will be looking at maps to locate different countries and explore together the world around us. Through our topic we will develop our geography language and field work skills.

History

We will be finding out how transport has changed and developed over the years and who invented what!

Computing

We will be developing our computer and keyboard skills and developing our understanding of programmable toys.
