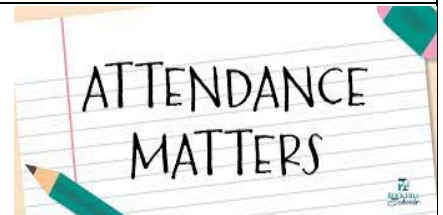


We now have a card machine which we are just setting up and hope to be able to take card payments in the school office very soon.

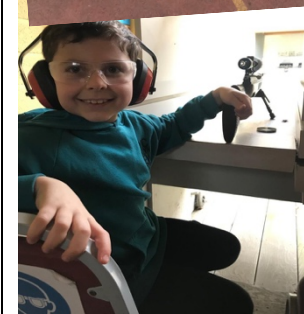

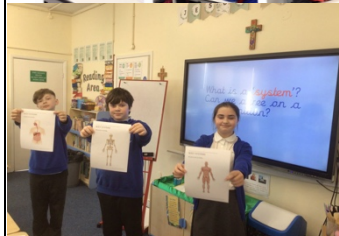

This week in assembly we read the story of when Jesus visited the temple and was angry at what he saw. The temple resembled a marketplace rather than a place of worship. We discussed how the sellers and moneychangers were making lots of money by treating people unfairly. The fact that they were treating people unfairly in the Temple, in God's house, meant that they were also disrespecting God too. This made Jesus angry.



We talked about whether seeing people treated unfairly sometimes makes us angry, too. Jesus taught us that all people are God's children; so we must treat each other with love and respect. Feeling and expressing anger when we see unfairness is okay; but doing nothing to change that unfairness is not. As children of God, we have a responsibility to change our world for the better. That means challenging unfairness whenever we see it. And we don't have to turn over tables to do this, we can challenge unfairness gently. We can show people a fairer way to live by setting a good example. We can share our concerns with others and ask for their help. Sometimes lots of people have to come together to bring about fairness.
