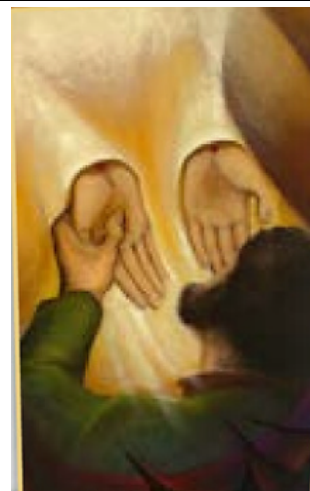

This week in assembly we have celebrated the resurrection of Jesus. We read the Gospel story of ‘Doubting Thomas’ and thought about what makes us believe something is really true. Thomas struggled to believe until he saw Jesus with his own eyes, then he believed that Jesus really had risen from the dead! But Thomas’s change of heart went further. The words he said to Jesus: “My Lord and my God”, show that Thomas realised Jesus was God.
