## Maths

In Maths we will be covering

- Geometry-Properties of shape
- Geometry-Position and direction
- Sats revision –arithmetic and reasoning
- Using calculation and problem solving skills to take part in maths investigations and applying them to everyday situations

## Science

### Light:

- We will recognise that light travels in straight lines
- We will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light in the eye
- We will explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- We will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
