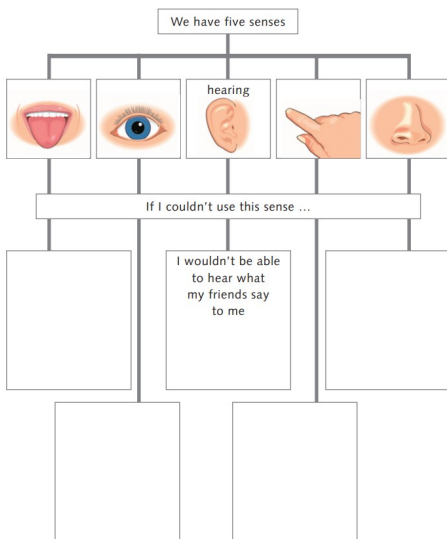

 A basic understanding that our body parts have a function.

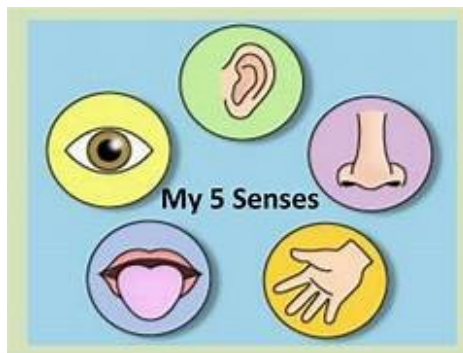

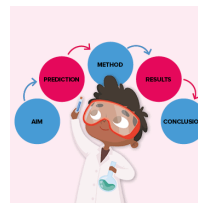

Vocabulary

Hear	We hear sounds with our ears.
Human	A person.
See	We see things with our eyes.
Sense	There are five senses: Sight, touch, taste, hearing and smell.
Skin	Skin covers our bodies and allows us to feel through touching things.
Smell	We smell through our noses.
Taste	We taste with our tongues.
Touch	We touch things through our skin all over our bodies.
