Donations so far. There have been some incredibly generous donations. We will be continuing to collect items up until 25th October for the Food Bank.

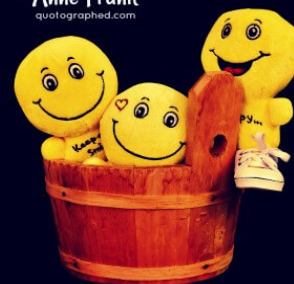
SEE SAW Messaging App

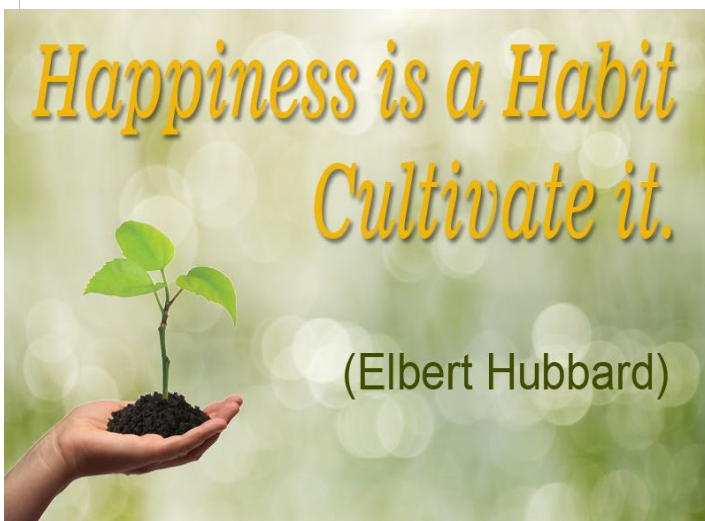
