costumes and designed their own clowns. They were also wowed with the circus skills demonstration show!



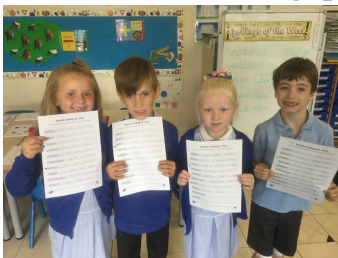
