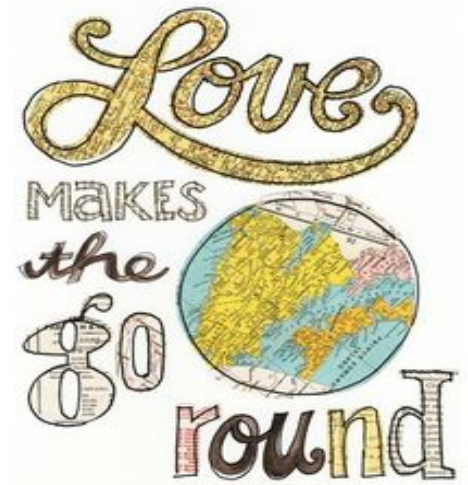


## Homework

**Poor attendance can result in a Penalty Notice being issued by Wirral Council. A Penalty Notice can be issued where any of the following occur:**

- The child has had 10 or more sessions of absence in a period of no more than one term or two half terms.
- The child has 10 sessions (half days) of unauthorised leave of absence in term time.
- The child has taken leave of absence in term time without parents requesting authorisation from the school.
- The child arrives late after the registers are closed on 10 or more separate occasions in any one term.
