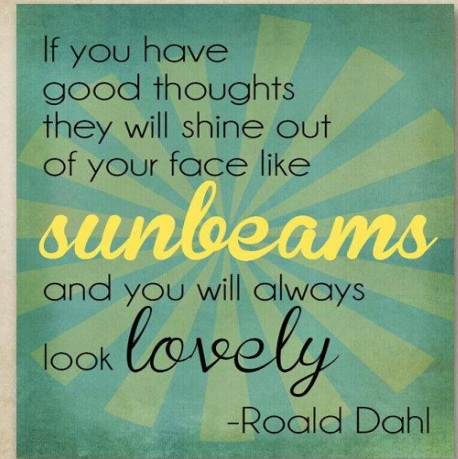
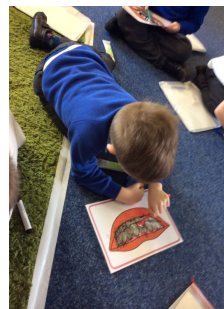
School Council - Across the school, each class have been voting for their school council members. The chosen representatives are –
