Christmas Parties

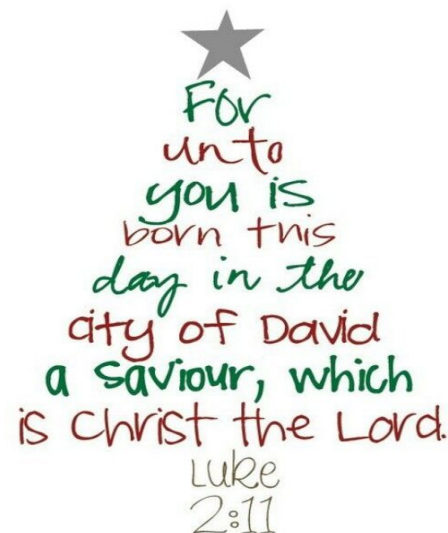
Great fun was had by all at their 'Christmas Party Day' on Wednesday.
