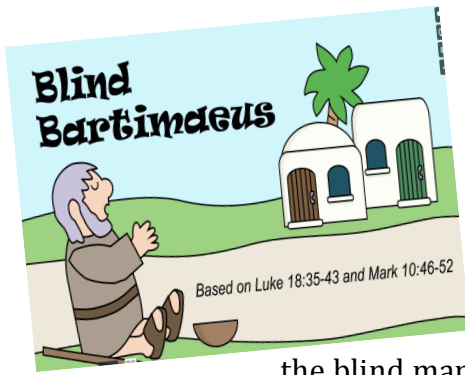

## Our Values for November are... **EMPATHY & UNDERSTANDING**

**Definition of empathy:** Understanding what it is like to be someone else and feeling what they are feeling



We started the week in assembly thinking about what 'empathy' means and how we can show 'empathy'. We thought about what it feels like to be in other people's shoes and shared examples of how we can understand others feelings. We discussed how Jesus showed empathy towards others and we listened to the story of 'Bartimaeus' from Luke's Gospel. Jesus showed empathy and understanding towards

the blind man whilst others didn't. This month in school we are going to try to demonstrate the values of empathy and understanding by considering others feelings.
