forward to seeing if their bug castles are still standing by next week's Forest School morning.

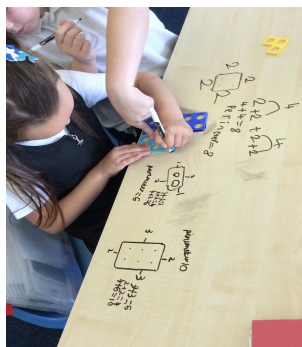
