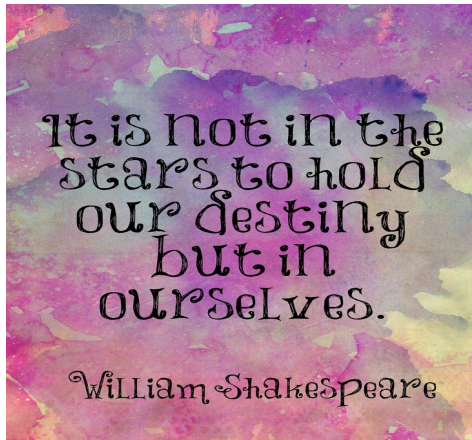
**Year 2** had a wonderful school trip to the Catalyst Museum.



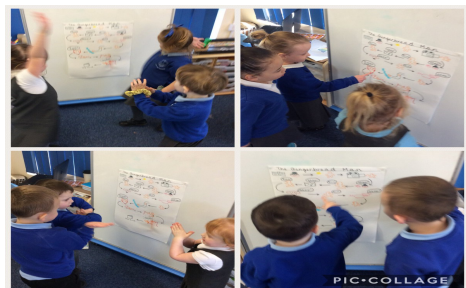
There was so much to do and to find out about. The children explored experiments and learnt new facts.
