The children have researched information about Judaism using iPads and laptops

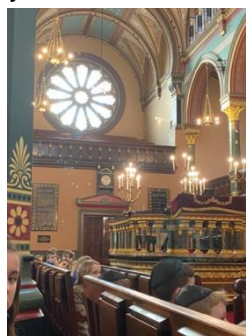
finding out about important signs, symbols and traditions associated with Judaism.

The children spotted the Star of David on the tiled floor and

heard that the synagogue was only built because of donations from worshippers, whose names were listed on

plaques. The inside of the synagogue was overwhelmingly beautiful. The children looked at Hebrew



writing and practised Hebrew words, like 'shalom' - hello/goodbye. They learnt about the 'eternal light'



which must never go out and saw the ark and the Torah. The Torah scroll could be unravelled the length of a

football pitch!
