Our School Council are currently working hard to create an Anti ~ Bullying Charter. We will keep you all informed of our progress.

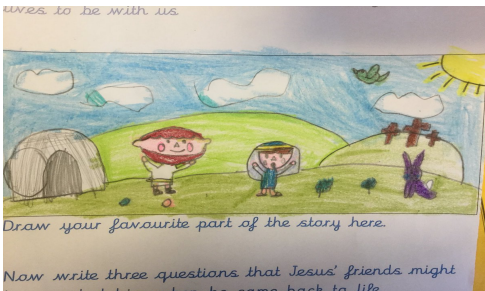
Little Angels

In RE we continue to think about the events of Easter. I was so impressed by this beautiful illustration of the resurrection story from a Y2 child!



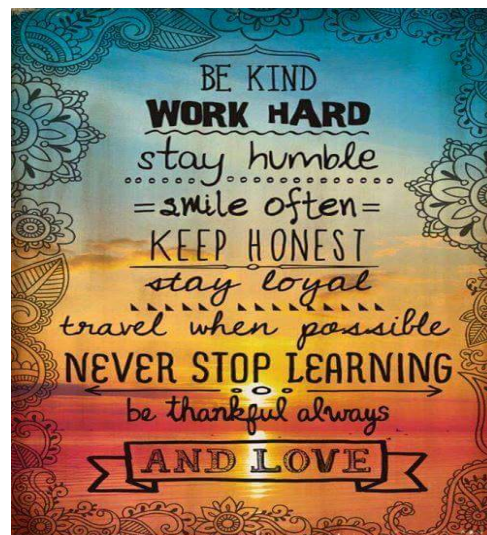
Thank you
