The Feast Day of St Michael the Archangel

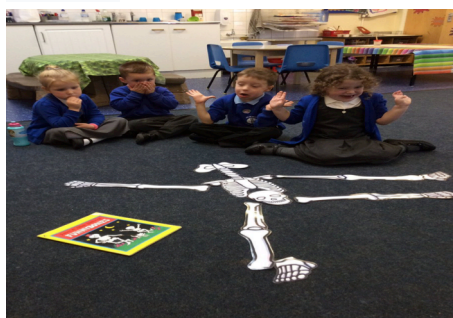

In their topic work, Year 3 have been archaeologists on a dig in search of artefacts from the Viking times.



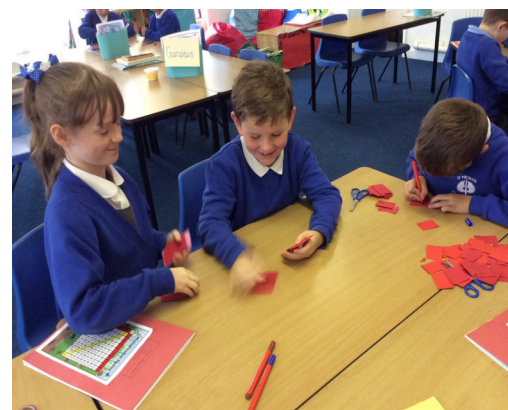
