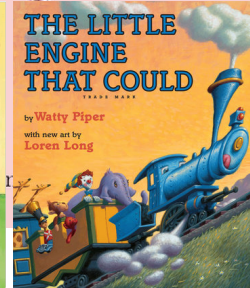
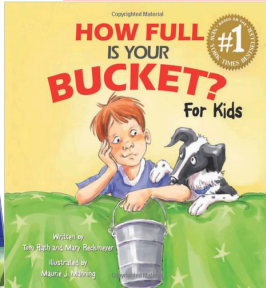
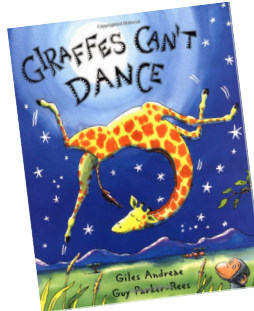

POSITIVITY is about....

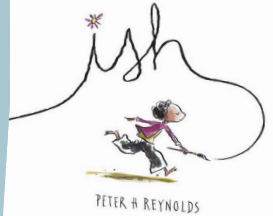
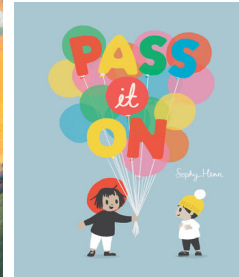
