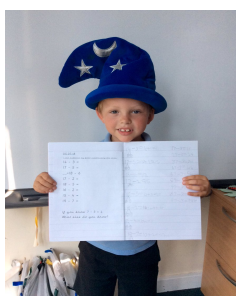
Healthy Living

Please remember holidays will not be authorised during term time and this time away from school will affect your child’s progress. Good attendance is considered to be anything above 96%.

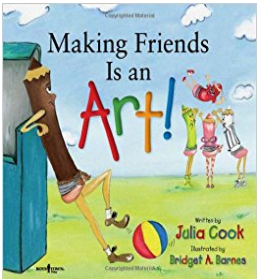
