Attendance – We are

worryingly one of the worst 10 primary schools in Wirral, for overall poor attendance and persistent absence and this therefore means it is a key priority and target for Governors.

We cannot stress enough the importance of good attendance and the impact being absent from school has on your child's progress in

school. We will be continuing to target families where attendance is a concern and the ESW service will be working closely with the school to promote good attendance. Good attendance at our school means being in school at least 96% of the time or 180 to 190 days.

We will not authorise any holidays taken during term time and all holidays during term time will incur a penalty warning/fine.

Our value for the month is 'co-operation'.....this is a great value for September when we are encouraging the children to work together in their new classes and be a 'team'. This week we have been thinking about how we show others how to co-operate by....

- Listening to other peoples opinions and including others' ideas.
- Being supportive of other people's ideas, even when you might not agree with them.

- Making visitors and new people feel welcome.

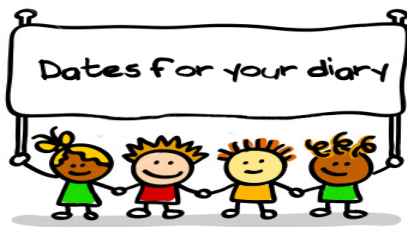
