Digital Imagery


Children will learn how to use a digital camera to take pictures, we will then decide which need to be deleted and use software to adapt these images.

Maths


We will continue working on, consolidating and securing the children's knowledge of the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Geography/History

The children will develop their understanding of chronology and the terms BC and AD.

We will be looking at where Egypt is and at aspects of geography including the River Nile and its importance for the Egyptians. We will compare life in Ancient Egypt and life today.

Science

Light

We will continue to

- Recognise that we need light in order to see things, that dark is the absence of light and notice that light is reflected from surfaces
- Learn how to protect our eyes from the dangers of the sun.
- Explore how shadows are formed
- Find patterns in the way that the sizes of shadows change.



Plants

We will be:

- Learning about the different parts of a plant and their functions.
- Exploring the requirements of a plant to grow.
- Investigating how water is transported within plants.
- Exploring the role of flowers in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

Children will:


- Write a range of Persuasive texts
